IMRIS is a Winnipeg-based company that provides image guided therapy solutions for global neurosurgical, cardiovascular and neurovascular markets. The company's integrated suites incorporate magnetic resonance, fluoroscopy and computed tomography for on-demand imaging during surgical and interventional procedures.

PRODUCT PORTFOLIO

IMRISneuro provides surgeons with high resolution MR images during neurosurgical procedures.

IMRIScardio provides clinicians with timely and accurate images for visualizing the cardiovascular system before, during and after interventions for the treatment of atrial fibrillation and certain structural heart disorders.

IMRISNV sequentially employs MRI and fluoroscopy in an integrated suite that provides interventional clinicians with imaging for the rapid assessment and post procedure evaluation of neurovascular conditions including stroke.

ONGOING INNOVATION

IMRIS is moving forward with two new major product development initiatives:

Image guided surgical robotics

IMRIS is bringing together the detailed imaging of MR with the precision of surgical robotics. This will enhance a surgeon's ability to perform microsurgery and biopsy-stereotaxy procedures. The first generation of the robotic system is already operating in a clinical trial.

MR guided radiation therapy

IMRIS recognizes the potential significant benefits that MR imaging guidance could offer to radiation therapy. In October 2010, IMRIS partnered with Varian Medical, a world leader in the provision of radiotherapy products for the treatment of cancer. IMRIS' planned product will combine IMRIS's magnetic resonance imaging platform with Varian's TrueBeam™ linear accelerator.

IMRIS is the first Winnipeg-based company listed on the Nasdaq (2010) exchange.

IMRIS's patented magnetic resonance imaging technology is now installed in 41 hospitals around the world including Brigham and Women's Hospital, Johns Hopkins Hospital, the Mayo Clinic, Foothills Medical Centre, Princess Margaret Hospital (U.S.), Canberra Hospital (Australia), PLA General Hospital (China) and Winnipeg's Health Sciences Centre (Canada).

IMRIS has sales offices in Canada, U.S., Europe, India, China, Japan and Australia.

IMRIS is the largest private-sector image-guided R & D facility in Canada.

COMPANY HISTORY

The original company (Magnetic Resonance Imaging Systems Inc) was created in March 1997 as a spin-off from the National Research Council of Canada's Institute for Biodiagnostics. After acquiring all of the assets and assuming all of the liabilities of Innovative Magnetic Resonance Imaging Systems Incorporated, the company was incorporated under the *Canada Business Corporations Act* in 2005
