

Cases: 830.6 thousand


Deaths: 21.3 thousand

Second wave of COVID-19 infections are falling, as shown by falling daily case counts.

While Manitoba remains in a code red, restrictions were eased on:


- January 23, 2021, and

Risks: Canada's COVID-19 Vaccine Delivery - 84 million over 2021 – Plan and Actual-to-Date










Manitoba's GDP by Industry Share, 2019

Manitoba's all industries GDP was \$63.3 billion in 2019.

When we group the sectors:

- Commercial Services are 48.2 per cent
- Goods are 29 per cent
- Non-Commercial Services are 22.8 per cent.



Manitoba Total Food Services and Drinking Places Y/Y Index (100 = same as previous year)











Winnipeg Int'l Airport aircraft movements

Canada YoY Index of Qtr Airline Operating Revenues












Manitoba's Employment Level Unadjusted (thousands)



Manitoba Employment by Month (Jan 2021)


Employment Level (Jan 2021):

- 622 thousand,
- Unchanged on the month.

Strength:

- Manufacturing non-durables (index of 110):
 - Food processing strong due to large harvest this year.

Weakness:


- Natural resources (Index of 75)
- Utilities (Index of 68)

Manitoba <u>Services</u> Employment Y/Y Index (Jan 2021)

Strength:

- Wholesale Trade (index of 121)
 - Sales in the wholesale sector doing well.

Weakness:

- Accommodation and food services (Index of 62)
 - Travel restrictions and lockdowns are weighing on this sector








2021-01 Unemployment Rate (%)

- Manitoba's unemployment rate 8.1 per cent,
- Canada's unemployment rate 9.8 per cent.

Of great policy concern is the unemployment rate of:


- those aged 15 to 24, and
- for women.
- The lockdowns used to control COVID-19 outbreaks have fallen on these two groups most heavily.







Housing Starts, and Population Growth (2015 – 2020)










Non-Residential Capital Investment in Buildings (\$Millions)

December 2020 Sales:


- \$1.68 billion

- Y/Y Growth: +4.4 per cent








Manitoba Manufacturing Sales by Industry















Manitoba Retail Trade – December 2020


- YoY Index 97, down 3 per cent.
- \$1.78 billion in Dec 2020
- retail sales have suffered due to code red, but to a lesser extent than the initial lockdown, due to adjustments.

December 2020 Manitoba Retail Trade by Industry

Strong Y/Y Index (100 = same as prior year):

- Building Materials (Index of 128)
- Health and personal (Index of 120)
- Food and beverage (Index of 119)

Weak Y/Y Index: (down on lockdowns and nonessential goods)

- General merchandise (index of 75)
- Sports, hobby, book, music (index of 70)
- Clothing (index of 39)








Canada's Retail E-commerce Sales Index

Canada's Retail E-commerce Sales Index – Dec'20


- Record high \$4.7 billion in December 2020
- E-commerce sales consistently higher than prior year by 64 per cent or more since April 2020







Manitoba 2020 Merchandise Trade by Month (\$Millions)










Index of Manitoba's Domestic Exports by Commundex (100 = same as prior year)

Strength:

- Farm, Fishing & Food Products (Index = 157)
- Forestry Products (Index = 121)
- Electronics electrical equipment (index = 117)

Y/Y Weakness:

- Aircraft and Transportation Equipment (index = 49)
- Motor Vehicles (index = 49)








Contribution to the deviation of inflation from 2 per cent, quarterly data



Shows COVID-19 driven changes to Manitoba provincial revenues and expenditures as of December 2020.







Weakness:

• High contact industries continue to suffer, along with their suppliers. E.g. Tourism, accommodations, airline passengers, restaurants.

• Strengths:

 Ecommerce, Air cargo, food manufacturing, wholesale trade, construction/renovation supply chain, fabricated metal, machinery and equipment


• Innovations:
