MANITOBA WHOLESALE SALES APRIL 2021 BUILDING MATERIAL SALES PROPEL HIGHER SECTOR RESULTS




Bottom Line

Canada's **building materials** sales continue to show great strength, driven by higher lumber prices and continued consumer demand for renovations and building projects. **Machinery equipment** sales continue to show strength nationally.

In Manitoba, strong year-over-year sales of building materials, machinery and equipment are supporting the sector on an aggregate level. The wholesaling sector is expected to continue to expand, given strong consumer demand and the sector's robust performance in the face of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Cdn Wholesale Sales

In April 2021, Canada's wholesale sales rose to **\$72 billion**, up 10 per cent over February 2020. /1

Cdn Wholesale Sales by subsector

- Building materials wholesale sales in April 2021 were up 45 per cent over February 2020. This was supported by strong wood product manufacturing sales, driven by unprecedent price levels for lumber as discussed in our last issue.
- Farm Product sales in April 2021 were up 21 per cent over February 2020.
- Machinery equipment sales in April 2021 were up 15% over February 2020.
- Only motor vehicle sales in April 2021 were down (-15 per cent) versus February 2020.

Canada's top four wholesale sales subsectors in April 2021 by share of total sales were: **Machinery equipment** (21.3%), **Building materials** (18.3%), **Food, beverage, and tobacco** (17.4%), and **Motor vehicles** (14.2%).


Lumber Futures

Random length lumber futures for July 2021 hit a peak in mid-May and since have dropped significantly (closing at US\$842.3/mbft on June 24, 2021). As a result, we expect building materials sales to be strong when the May 2021 figures are released.

APR'21 CANADIAN WHOLESALE SALES




Wholesale Trade Inventory/Sales Ratio

The Canada level data indicates that the inventory/sales ratio for **[416]** - **Building material and supplies merchant wholesalers** continues to be tight. For Jan - Apr, building material inventory was typically held for just a bit more than a month, so we can expect to see softness at the manufacturing level to begin being reflect about 1 - 1.5 months afterwards in the wholesale sector – so long as lumber futures continue to ease toward a more normal level.

Manitoba's wholesale sales in April 2021 were \$1.64 billion, up 7 per cent over February 2020, but down 1.2% over March 2021.



MB Wholesale sales by subsector

- Building materials wholesale sales in April 2021 were up 36 per cent over February 2020. This increase was supported by strong wood product manufacturing sales.
- Machinery equipment sales in April 2021 were up 24% over February 2020.
- Farm Product sales in April 2021 were up 10 per cent over February 2020.

MB Wholesaling Trade by subsector share in April 2021

Manitoba's top three wholesale sales subsectors in April 2021 by share of total sales were: **Machinery equipment** (23.5%), **Food, beverage, and tobacco** (19.1%), and **Building materials** (17%).

If inventory/sales ratios at the Canadian level are similar to Manitoba, we should see a similar easing of lumber prices at the manufacturing level at the wholesale level within a few months of that easing.
