Programs and incentives

Industry Expansion Program (IEP) provides financial support to companies that are locating new operations in Manitoba or expanding existing operations. The program contributes to the company's investment in skills training for employees. Manitoba's Industry Expansion Program has the potential to offer between \$2-6 million to support employee training.

Innovation Growth Program provides support to small and medium sized businesses that are pursing innovation and new opportunities. The Innovation Growth Program is cost-shared with recipients, with Manitoba providing up to 50% of the total project. Under the program firms may apply for a non-repayable grant of up to \$100,000 per project to cost-share eligible expenses on a 50/50 basis.

Workforce Development Program helps companies to assess human resource (HR) management needs and develop and implement HR and workforce training and development plans. Support under this program is custom-prepared on a client-by-client basis. The amount of funding assistance provided is based on numerous factors including the net economic and other benefits to the Province of Manitoba, training reasons, outcomes and costs, workforce impact, to name a few.










<u>Startup TNT</u> is an angel network that connects local pre-seed startups and entrepreneurs with community members and other investors,.







2032 are experienced in data, IT, and software






Manitoba is **lower than the Canadian average by 13%** in most tech salaries. This allows you to save money and grow faster.


